1. **HELP! FIX ME –Maine’s Low Cost Spay/Neuter program**

If you receive or are eligible for one of the following programs:

- Food Stamps
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Social Security Disability (SSD)
- Maine Care (Medicaid)

You can have your cat fixed for \$10, and your dog fixed for \$20.

- Limit of 3 vouchers per year

- Includes rabies vaccination
